## **ELIGIBILITY:**

This tournament is open to all male and female contestants registered and in good standing with the United States Judo Federation (USJF), USA Judo, or the United States Judo Association (USJA) and must be a **minimum of five years old as of February 25, 2023.**

All contestants must present their valid USJF, USA Judo, or USJA membership card at the time of registration. Any contestant unable to present their valid registration card will be required to purchase or renew membership prior to acceptance of the entry form for this Tournament.

Contestants, the parents of minor contestants and the instructors are responsible for ensuring that the contestant be familiar with the sport of Judo and have sufficient ability to safely compete in the tournament.

## **REGISTRATION AND WEIGH-IN REQUIREMENTS:**

For our pre-tournament preparations, we will require an official weight for each contestant from their club. *Please use the attached spreadsheet.* Email to [ore.idajudo@gmail.com](mailto:ore.idajudo@gmail.com) by midnight February 23<sup>rd</sup>.

There will be a \$50 late fee for anyone wanting to submit weigh-in after the February 23 deadline. You must either call or show up at our dojo between 6:00 and 8:00pm, Friday February 24th. Phone number is (541) 889-4936.

No weigh-ins will be allowed after that time!

Information for each division and 2<sup>nd</sup> entry to be verified at registration.

All weight division categories are subject to change. The weight divisions will be determined upon receipt of all entries. Contestants who exceed the maximum weight allowed for their age group will be placed in the next older age group. Excessive weight contestants will be determined at the discretion of the tournament committee. Coaches, Instructors, & Parent will be notified and have an opportunity to review the categories and confirm their child's/athlete's suitability for participation.

All contestants must present a completed registration. A completed Tournament Entry Form, 2<sup>nd</sup> Entry Form, Waiver and Release of Liability Form and presentation of a valid USJF, USA Judo or USJA card must be completed before entry.

### Juniors: 2-minute matches\*

M/F	5- 6 years old	Light, Middle and Heavy
M/F	7- 8 years old	Light, Middle, and Heavy
M/F	9-10 years old	Light, Middle, Lt. Heavy and Heavy
M/F	11-12 years old	Light, Middle, Lt. Heavy and Heavy

### Intermediates: 3-minute matches\*\*\*

M/F	13-14 years old	Light, Middle and Heavy
M/F	15-16 years old	Light, Middle and Heavy

### Seniors: 4-minute matches

M/F	White Belt	Light, Middle and Heavy
	Kansetsu-waza (joint lock) techniques <b>not allowed.</b>	
M/F	Brown Belt	Light, Middle and Heavy
	Kansetsu-waza (joint lock) techniques <b>not allowed.</b>	
M/F	Black Belt	Light, Middle and Heavy

All contestants must compete in their own age and weight division prior to competing in next higher age division. Only Senior Brown 1 kyu may compete in the Black Belt Division. Only one 2nd entry will be accepted per player into the next older age group. Players competing in a higher division will compete at the higher division rules. There is no mandatory rest period for the player between matches of different divisions.

## **TOURNAMENT RULES:**

Current International Judo Federation (IJF) contest rules with the following modifications:

8M x 8M contest area with 4M safety area

.The CARE System will be used.

\* Drop Knee Seionage will **not** be allowed for Juniors 12yrs and under.

\*\*\*Shime-waza (choking techniques) will be allowed for 13 years and older.

Kansetsu-waza (joint lock techniques) will be allowed for Black belt only.

Golden Score time limit will be match time. First score wins match. Hantei decision will be called if tie remains after 1 Golden score match.

IJF dress code of gray slacks, white shirt, black tie and black sport coat would be appreciated for judges. A white dress shirt and dark slacks will be allowed for Brown belt judges, as needed.

Additional changes or modifications may be made to ensure the safety of participants.

A true double elimination scoring system will be used.

Changes can be made at the discretion of the Tournament director.

## **Health Guidelines:**

- Individuals actively experiencing symptoms, including fever, cough, sore throat, and fatigue will not participate.
- Masks or face coverings are not required, although all should follow personal, local/state health guidelines.
- Continue to sanitize/wash hands frequently.
- There should be NO SHARING of towels, water bottles, liquids and food.
- All judogi's and belts should be clean.

## **AWARDS:**

First, second and third place awards will be given in each division.

Awards will be presented after each division is completed. Contestants will be called to trophy presentation.
