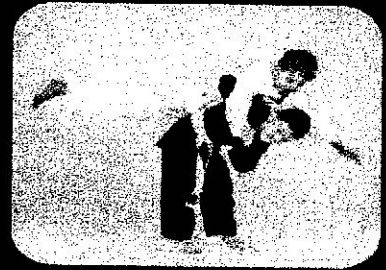

Rules

Competitors and coaches will need a valid USA, USJF, USJA Judo Membership.

Events will use a Modified IJF Rule Set

These events are designed to give the best possible experience for the athlete.

Coaches and referees should work together to create a positive experience for the athletes.

1-3 Referees per mat area. No Care system is used at this event.

Below is a list of rules that are being modified from the IJF Rule Set.

MATCH TIMES

YOUTH DIVISION MATCH TIMES:

All Youth Divisions have 2-minute match times.

Golden Score is 2 minutes.

13 -17 AGE DIVISION MATCH TIMES:

Teenage Divisions have 3-minute match times.

Golden Score is 2 minutes.

CHOKING ALLOWED FOR AGES 13-17 REGULAR DIVISIONS ONLY

NO ARMLOCKS ALLOWED IN ANY DIVISION



COACHING

Coaching is encouraged at all times during the matches regardless of the division of the competitor (coaching throughout the match is allowed).

What does it mean to coach your athlete:

All comments from the coach should be geared towards helping your athlete perform a judo technique.

As long as coaches are being a positive influence over the athlete they will be encouraged to continue coaching.

PENALTIES

NOVICE DIVISIONS

Shidos will not be handed out for **Minor infractions**

Referees will first warn the judoka about infractions and instruct them not to do so in the future.

REGULAR DIVISIONS

If a judoka gets 3 Shidos they will lose the match.

Referees will use their discretion to give penalties

Penalties include: Running out of bounds, defensive posture, false attacks, defensive gripping, or any action deemed to prevent their opponent from positive judo.



WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, in any Judo tournament, practice, clinic, and related events and activities ("Activity") of the USA Judo/United States Judo, Inc., ATJA, Joseki Dojo, I agree:

1. I understand the nature of Judo activities and believe I am qualified to participate in such Activity. I also understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. I further acknowledge that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, and elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
3. I acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, illness or disease, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due not only to my own actions, inactions or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, illness, disease, permanent disability, or death.
5. I hereby release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the USA Judo/United States Judo, Inc., ATJA, Joseki Dojo, together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, officers, agents, coaches, and other employees, or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, legal guardians, supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners, lessors, and lessees of premises used in conducting the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "Releasees", from any and all litigation expenses, attorney damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Releasees or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law.
